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**AN ACT Including Teacher Assistants and Aides Under State Retirement System.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 5, § 1001, sub-§ 10, amended.** The first sentence of subsection 10 of section 1001 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

“Employee” shall mean any regular classified or unclassified officer or employee in a department, including teachers in the state colleges and for the purposes of this chapter, teachers, **teacher assistants and teacher aides** in the public schools, but shall not include any Justice of the Superior Court or Supreme Judicial Court who is now or may be later entitled to retirement benefits under Title 4, section 5, and Title 4, section 103, nor shall it include any Judge of the District Court who is now or may be later entitled to retirement benefits under Title 4, chapter 5, nor shall it include any member of the State Police who is now entitled to retirement benefits under Title 25, chapter 195.
