COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 609, L. D. 797, Bill,  
"An Act to Grant a Charter to the Town of Pittsfield."

Amend said Bill in section 2.06 by striking out all of  
subsection (b) (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'(b) Forfeiture of office. A councilman shall forfeit his  
office if he (1) lacks at any time during his term of office  
any qualifications for the office prescribed by this charter or  
by law, (2) violates any express prohibition of this charter,  
(3) sustains a final conviction of a felony, or (4) fails to  
attend 3 consecutive regular meetings of the council without being  
excused by the council.'

Further amend said Bill in section 6.04 by adding at the  
end of subsection (a) (same in L.D.) the following sentence:  
'When a member is unable to act because of interest, physical  
incapacity or absence for any other reason the associate member  
shall serve in his stead.'
