COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 610, L. D. 798, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Auburn Sewerage District."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end (same in L.D.) the
following Referendum:

'Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of
State. This Act shall not take effect unless it is approved by
the legal voters of the district at any regular or special election
to be called and held for the purpose not later than January 1,
1970 by the municipal officers of the City of Auburn. Said election
shall be called, advertised and conducted according to the laws
relating to municipal elections to the extent applicable thereto.

The city clerk of Auburn shall prepare the required ballots.
He shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following
question:

"Shall the Act to Amend the Charter of the Auburn Sewerage
District, passed by the 104th Legislature, be accepted?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed
against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

The result of the vote in said district shall be declared by the
municipal officers of the City of Auburn and due certificate thereof
filed by the city clerk of Auburn with the Secretary of State, and if
said result so filed shows that a majority of the vote is for approval
of this Act, it shall take complete effect; provided, that the total

number of votes cast for or against the acceptance of this Act equals or exceeds 20% of the total eligible voters which had been previously determined by a certificate and list filed by the registrar of voters of Auburn.
