HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 611, L. D. 799, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Use of Scallop Drags in Gouldsboro Bay."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting at the end,
before the period, the words 'and Fishing in Narraguagus River'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation
and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following
new section:

'Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1959, §108-B, additional. Chapter 155 of
of the private and special laws of 1959 is amended by adding a new
section 108-B, to read as follows:

Sec. 108-B. Fishing in Narraguagus River. It shall be unlawful
to use any type of net or seine in the Narraguagus River and its
tributaries from May 1st to October 15th of each year in that portion
of the river between the so-called Great Bridge in the Town of
Milbridge and the bridge at U. S. Route 1 in Cherryfield.

This section does not apply to the taking of alewives under
section 108-A, nor to the taking of alewives under any other law.
This section shall not apply to the taking of smelts under Title
12, section 4101.'
