SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 614, L.D. 802, Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Grant Adult Rights to Persons Twenty Years of Age and to Reduce the Voting Age to Twenty Years.

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Reduce the Voting Age to Eighteen Years.'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the 3rd paragraph the following:

'Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 15th line (13th line of L.D.) the underlined word "twenty" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'eighteen'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the last line of the 6th paragraph the word "Twenty" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Eighteen'

Proposed by Senator BELIVEAU of Oxford.
