RESOLVE, Authorizing Construction of Connecting Building Between Shops at Maine State Prison from Prison Industries Account.

Construction of connecting building between shops at Maine State Prison from Prison Industries Account; authorized. Resolved: That the warden of the Maine State Prison is authorized to expend from the Prison Industries Account a sum not to exceed \$18,000 for the construction of a connecting building between the Tailor Shop and the Wood Shop at the Maine State Prison.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is considered necessary and desirable in the interest of the prison security and the better and safer utilization of the prison industrial shop area that the Tailor Shop and Wood Shop at the Maine State Prison, which are now approximately 20 feet distant from each other, be connected by the construction of a connecting building.
