**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Elwood A. Jepson of Norridgewock for
Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.**

Elwood A. Jepson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to Elwood A. Jepson of Norridgewock for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route 2 in Norridgewock.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Jepson's well was contaminated by salt used on Route 2 and cannot be used for drinking or cooking and the plumbing fixtures are being corroded.
