STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Short Term Permits for Trucks to Haul Loads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 246, amended. The last paragraph of section 246 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

When a truck is already registered, the owner, by paying an additional fee, may receive a short-term permit allowing him to haul loads of larger tonnage for a limited period of 6 month or less than one year. No such permit shall be issued for less than one month and no permit shall extend beyond the expiration of the regular license. The fee shall be a percentage of the difference between the owner's present annual registration fee and the annual fee for the desired tonnage and shall be computed according to the following table:

1-month	permit	 20%
2-month	permit	 30%
3-month	permit	 40%
4-month	permit	 50%
5-month	permit	 60%
6-month	permit	 70%
7-month	permit	 75%
8-month	permit	 80%
II month	permit	 95%
