RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Howard Pond, Oxford County.

Fishing in Howard Pond, Oxford County. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 trout or salmon in the aggregate, and limiting fishing to fly fishing only and the trolling of artificial lures on Howard Pond, Hanover in Oxford County.
