

STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H. P. 636, L. D. 824, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Municipal Public Employees Labor Relations Law."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by adding at the end the following section (same in L.D.):

§ 973. Director of Public Employer

The Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, shall appoint a Director for Public Employer for a term of 6 years and until his successor is appointed and qualified. The director's salary shall be established by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council.

The director's duty shall be to advise and aid any public employer under this chapter in dealing with the duties and responsibilities of the public employer.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 1, a new section, as follows (same in L.D.)

<u>'Sec. 1-A.</u> Appropriated. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of Director for Public Employer the sum of \$39,400 to carry out the purposes of the office. The breakdown shall be as follows:
