

STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 638, L. D. 826, Bill, "An Act Providing for a Council-Manager Charter for the Town of Vassalboro."

Amend said Bill in section 207 by striking out all of subsection II (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'II. Forfeiture of office. A councilman shall forfeit his office upon final conviction of a felony or if he lacks at any time during his term of office any qualifications of the office prescribed by this charter or by law.'

Further amend said Bill in section 303 by striking out all of paragraphs D and E of subsection II (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'D. The hours of work, attendance regulations and provisions for sick and vacation leave;

E. Other practices and procedures necessary to the administration of the town personnel system; and

<u>F.</u> The policies and procedures regarding the right of appeal to the Personnel Appeals Board.

III. Personnel appeals board. There shall be a personnel appeals board consisting of 3 members appointed by the town council from among the qualified voters of the town. The first appointments to this board shall be made in the following manner: One member for 3 years, one member for 2

years and one member for one year. All succeeding appointments shall be made for terms of 3 years. '

Further amend said Bill in section 601 by adding at the end (same in L.D.) the following sentence: 'When a member is unable to act because of interest, physical incapacity or absence for any other reason the associate member shall serve in his stead.'

Further amend said Bill in section 702 by striking out all of the last sentence (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: 'A committee member shall forfeit his office upon final conviction of a felony or if he lacks at any time during his office any qualifications of the office prescribed by this charter or by law.'

Further amend said Bill in the Referendum by striking out all of the first sentence (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: 'This Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the Town of Vassalboro at any regular or special town election until December 31, 1970.'
