IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 11th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 414 of the public laws of 1967, which relates to Penobscot County, is further amended to read as follows:

Penobscot County: County commissioners, \$2,750 \$3,000; chairman, \$3,250; clerk of courts \$6,000 \$6,600; deputy clerk of courts, \$5,000 \$5,500; county attorney, \$6,000; first assistant county attorney, \$5,000; second assistant county attorney, \$4,000; county treasurer, \$3,500 \$3,900; sheriff, \$6,400 \$7,000; register of deeds, \$5,500 \$6,000; judge of probate, \$6,400 \$7,000; register of probate, \$5,300 \$5,800.
