IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes which relates to Knox County, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 414 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Knox County: County commissioners, \$1,200 \$1,500; clerk of courts, \$4,700 \$4,935; county attorney, \$5,000 \$5,250; county treasurer, \$1,500 \$1,575; sheriff, \$4,900 \$5,145; register of deeds, \$4,900 \$5,145; judge of probate \$3,200 \$5,000; register of probate, \$3,200 \$4,000.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$375 to provide for increase in salary of county attorney under this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
