STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Requiring Marking of Trailers Carrying Dangerous Liquids.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1756, amended. Section 1756 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 246 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

No person shall transport over any public way gasoline, chlorine, sodium or other liquids in bulk which are explosive, volatile or highly flammable unless the trailer in which the material is transported is plainly marked on either side with signs having letters not less than 4 inches in height setting forth the liquid being transported.
