STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Bass by Ice Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2651, amended. Section 2651 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 26 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

Unless otherwise provided by rule and regulation, it shall be lawful to take black bass through the ice during the same period that it is lawful to take salmon and trout.
