COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 263, L. D. 867, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Licensing of Ambulance Service, Vehicles and Per-
sonnel."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2 under-
lined sentences of subsection 1 of that part designated "§63."
and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sen-
tences: 'One member shall be a representative of a recognized
state safety association. Three members shall be representa-
tives of an accredited ambulance service with not less than 3
years of such active experience.'
