RESOLVE, to Reimburse Norman E. Dudley of Waite for Well Damage Caused by Road Construction and Highway Maintenance.

Norman E. Dudley; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,300, to be paid to Norman E. Dudley of Waite for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route I in Waite.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The land of Mr. Dudley, located on Route One, now lies below road level. Salt used on Route One has polluted his well. He has had to drill a new well on elevated land, now in operation, and this resolve is for actual cost.
