SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 684, L.D. 883, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Political Committees and Political Advertising."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following new
section:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 21, §1579, sub-§28, additional. Section
1579 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further
amended by adding a new subsection 28, to read as follows:

28. Unofficial specimen ballot. A person, candidate or
political committee who prepares or circulates a paper in the
form of a ballot or a part thereof on which is imprinted the
words SPECIMEN BALLOT or the instructions in section 701, sub-
section 2, paragraph A or section 702, subsection 2, paragraph C.
