SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 694, L.D. 894, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Weekly Benefits for Total Unemployment Under Employment
Security Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 2 (same in L.D.)
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. Weekly benefit amount for total unemployment. On and
after April 1, ~~1966~~ 1970, each eligible individual who is totally
unemployed in any week shall be paid with respect to such week,
benefits equal to ~~1/25~~ 1/22 of the wages, rounded to the nearest
dollar, paid to him in the high quarter of his base period, but
not less than \$10. The maximum weekly benefit amount for claimants
requesting insured status determination from June 1st of a calendar
year to May 31st of the next calendar year shall not exceed ~~50%~~ 52%
of the annual average weekly wage, rounded to the nearest dollar,
paid in the calendar year preceding June 1st of such calendar year.'
