HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 696, L.D. 896, Bill, "An Act Relating to Minimum Speed Under the Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 29, §1252, sub-§4, additional. Section 1252 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 20 of chapter 245 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding a new subsection 4, to read as follows:

4. Minimum speed regulation. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at such a slow speed as to impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic except when reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with the law.'
