AN ACT Relating to Minimum Speed Under the Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1253, amended. Section 1253 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

Whenever any person operating a motor vehicle causes a line of 7 or more motor vehicles behind him, said operator shall at the first reasonable opportunity turn to the right off the road or take other responsible action to allow other motor vehicles to overtake and pass safely.
