COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 700, L. D. 900, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Definition of Hotel Under Liquor Law."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 4th line of the first paragraph of subsection 9 (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "10" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '14'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of the 3rd paragraph of subsection 9 (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence: 'The commission is specifically authorized to make such rules and regulations as they deem necessary to carry out this section.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first underlined sentence of the 4th paragraph of subsection 9 (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence: 'Nothing in this subsection shall be held to prevent the commission from issuing part-time licenses to bona fide part-time hotels.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting in the 7th and 11th lines (same in L.D.) before the underlined words "not serving" the underlined words 'either serving or'
