SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 702, L. D. 902, Bill, "AN ACT  
Concerning the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 4. R.S., T. 28, §802-A, additional. Title 28 of the  
Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 802-A, to read  
as follows:

§802-A. Sunday sale on vessels

A spirituous and vinous liquor and malt liquor license issued  
to a vessel corporation under section 802, or a malt liquor license  
issued to a vessel company under section 753, shall authorize said  
licensee to sell liquor or malt liquor on Sundays between the hours  
of 7 a.m. and midnight when said vessels operated by the licensee  
are a distance in excess of 3 nautical miles off shore, notwithstanding  
section 4. Liquor and malt liquor shall be sold on Sundays only  
during the hours of 12 noon and midnight on vessels operated within  
said 3-mile limit.'
