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AN ACT Relating to a Change in the Exemptions Allowed in the  
Plumbing Laws.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 3302, repealed and replaced. Section 3302 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 3302. Exceptions

Regular employees of public utilities as defined in Title 35, section 15, when working as such, or regular employees of owners or lessees of real property, when working as such, or any oil burner man duly licensed under chapter 33, insofar as work covered by said license is involved, or persons whose occupation is the doing of miscellaneous jobs of manual labor in the course of which some incidental plumbing repairs or alterations are made by them, shall be subject only to subchapter II dealing with regulations and to section 3304, only insofar as it relates to violation of said regulations.
