**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Elmer L. Rogers of Berwick for Well Damage
by Highway Construction.**

Elmer L. Rogers; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,200 to be paid to Elmer L. Rogers of Berwick for damage to his well caused by highway construction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to relocation and construction of State Route 4 in Berwick, Mr. Rogers' well was damaged to the extent that it is no longer usable as a potable water source. Mr. Rogers was forced to carry water for nearly 2½ months until a driven well survey could be made and an artesian well driven at another location on his property.
