STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Formation of a School Administrative District in the Machias - East Machias Area.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. School Administrative District. The Towns of East Machias, Machiasport, Whiting and Cutler, notwithstanding any other provision of the statute to the contrary, are authorized to form a School Administrative District and contract with Washington Academy for secondary education. The State Board of Education shall, upon application from the above-mentioned towns, follow the procedures outlined in the Revised Statutes, Title 20, sections 215 to 307, permitting the various municipalities to take the necessary action to become a School Administrative District.

Sec. 2. Application. The State Board of Education may permit the formation of a School Administrative District in the area consisting of any number of towns including Machias and East Machias. Any such district formed shall have the authority to operate 2 secondary schools, one at Machias and one at Washington Academy.
