STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Town Road Improvement Fund for Bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 23, § 1702, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 1702 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

3. Improved highways. All improved sections of state and state aid highways; or

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 23, § 1702, sub-§ 4, additional. Section 1702 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 4, to read as follows:

4. Use of Town Road Improvement Fund. One-half the cost of construction of a bridge, when such bridge is on a town way and not eligible for aid under the Bridge Act, providing the inhabitants of the municipality so vote at their annual town meeting, or at a special meeting called for this purpose. Such moneys may continue to be used from year to year, until half of the cost has been defrayed.
