STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Franklin County: County commissioners, \$1,200; clerk of courts, \$4,700 \$5,200; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$7,300 \$1,500; sheriff, \$4,800 \$5,800; register of deeds, \$4,500 \$5,500; judge of probate, \$3,500; register of probate, \$4,500 \$5,000.
