# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Municipal Park and Conservation Commissions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., T. 30, § 3851, amended.** The first sentence of section 3851 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 203 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Municipalities may establish park and conservation commissions and choose by ballot. The municipal officers may appoint 5 park and conservation commissioners, to hold office 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 years, respectively, and after the first year choose annually a commissioner for 5 years in place of the one whose term expires such commission shall have the care and superintendence of the public parks and direct the expenditure of all moneys appropriated for the improvement of the same.'
