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**AN ACT Providing for a Statutory Agent for Foreign Domiciled Carriers  
Purchasing Six-year Trailer Plates.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 29, § 245-A, amended. Section 245-A of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph :

The Secretary of State shall require the appointment of a true and lawful agent or representative for each and every foreign domiciled carrier. The said agent shall be a Maine citizen and shall sign the registration certificate. All legal processes required to be served shall be served upon the agent, who to the best of his ability shall notify the carrier. This applies only to foreign domiciled individuals, partnerships or corporations applying for 6-year trailer plates.
