#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fall Trapping by Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 8, amended. Subsection 8 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 8. Spring and fall trapping by Penobscot Indians. In addition to any open trapping season provided by this section, there shall be an open season on muskrats from March 1st to May 1st and the month of October on all lands and islands belonging to the Penobscot Tribe of Indians. It shall be unlawful for any person not a member of said Penobscot Tribe to trap muskrats during such open season.
