COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 298, L.D. 991, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit Possession of Machine Guns."

Amend said Bill in that part of section 1 designated "§ 2323" by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'Machine guns manufactured, acquired, transferred or possessed in accordance with The National Firearms Act, as amended, shall be exempt from this chapter.'

Further amend said Bill in that part of section 1 designated "§ 2324" by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'Any machine gun as defined in section 2322, possessed in violation of this chapter, is declared to be contraband and is subject to forfeiture to the State. Any law enforcement officer shall have the power to seize the same with due process.'
