AN ACT Relating to Special Stores to Sell Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 28, § 153, amended. Section 153 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

§ 153. Special stores

The commission shall have authority to establish in cities and towns, which vote in favor of the operation of state stores under local option provisions and where there is no state store, special or temporary stores to be occupied ~~exclusively~~ for the purpose in such cities or towns of selling liquor in sealed bottles, containers or original packages for consumption off the premises under such regulations as they may determine.
