SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 774, L.D. 1007, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Accepting Gratuities by Liquor Commission
Members and Employees."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT Relating to Accepting Gratuities by State Officers
and Employees.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'R. S., T. 5, §13, additional. Title 5 of the Revised
Statutes is amended by adding a new section 13, to read as follows:

§ 13. Gratuities by state officers and employees

No state officer or employee, except as otherwise provided
by Title 28, section 52, shall accept directly or indirectly any
samples, gratuities, favors or anything of value from any person
or corporation. This section shall not apply to trade, manufacturing
or business association conventions at which state officers or
employees may be guests.'
