STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Accepting Gratuities by Liquor Commission Members and Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 52 amended. The last sentence of section 52 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 4 of chapter 151 of the private and special laws of 1967 and repealed and replaced by section 64 of chapter 544 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

Neither the commission, nor any employee, shall accept directly or indirectly any samples, gratuities, favors or anything of value from a manufacturer, seller, brewer or licensee or any representative of the same under circumstances which might reasonably be construed as influencing or improperly relating to past, present or future performance of his official duties.
