**AN ACT** Relating to Sunday Sale of Liquor if January 1st Falls on  
Sunday or Monday.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

Liquor may be sold on January 1st of any year from midnight to 2 a.m. ~~unless January 1st falls on Sunday.~~ If January 1st falls on Monday, licensees shall be permitted to sell or deliver any liquors between 9 p.m., Sunday, December 31st and 2 a.m., January 1st.
