STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Notice to Liquor Licensees When License to be Delayed for Cause.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 251, amended. Section 251 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

Any applicant for a license to sell liquor shall be notified and given a period of 60 days in which to become eligible under the commission's denial or failure to renew such application.
