AN ACT Providing for Fines in Lieu of Suspensions Under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 401, sub-§ 5, additional. Section 401 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 387 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding a new subsection 5, to read as follows:

5. Application. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the Administrative Hearing Commissioner shall no longer suspend any liquor licenses but in lieu thereof shall impose a fine of \$5 per day for each day such license would have been suspended, not to exceed \$200 for any one offense.
