## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Clerk of Courts and Providing for Deputy Clerk of Courts of Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 14th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, which relates to the salaries of county officials of Somerset County, is further amended to read as follows:

Somerset County: County commissioner, \$1,000; chairman, \$1,200; clerk of courts, \$5,150 \$7,900; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,600; county attorney, \$5,000; assistant county attorney, \$3,500; county treasurer, \$2,325; sheriff, \$4,950; register of deeds, \$4,950; judge of probate, \$4,950; register of probate, \$4,950.
