AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 14th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, which relates to Somerset County, is further amended to read as follows:

Somerset County: County commissioners, \$7,000 \$1,500; chairman, \$7,200 \$1,750; clerk of courts, \$5,150 \$5,750; county attorney, \$5,000; assistant county attorney, \$3,500; county treasurer, \$2,325 \$2,600; sheriff, \$4,950 \$5,750; register of deeds, \$4,950 \$5,750; judge of probate, \$4,950 \$5,750; register of probate, \$4,950 \$5,750.
