STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Gratuities for Members and Employees of Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 52, amended. The last sentence of section 52 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 4 of chapter 151 of the private and special laws of 1967 and repealed and replaced by section 64 of chapter 544 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed as follows:

Neither the commission, nor any employee, shall accept directly or indirectly any samples, gratuities, favors or anything of value from a manufacturer, seller, brewer or licensee or any representatives of the same.
