AN ACT Relating to Sale of Dogs from Kennels and Pet Shops.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 7, § 3407, additional. Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3407, to read as follows:

§ 3407. Sale of dogs from kennels and pet shops

All dogs and puppies sold from a licensed kennel or licensed pet shop, or both, in the State of Maine shall have a current health certificate and proof of proper immunization from a Maine licensed veterinarian; which certificate shall accompany the dog or puppy at the time of sale.

Any person convicted of violating this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for less than one year.
