RESOLVE, to Reimburse John P. Kennedy of Vassalboro for Loss of Sika Deer by Dogs.

John P. Kennedy; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Dog Tax Fund the sum of \$120 to reimburse John P. Kennedy of Vassalboro for 2 sika deer killed by dogs.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Kennedy of Vassalboro had 2 sika deer enclosed by an 8' fence and dogs dug under the fence killing the 2 deer. Warden Olan Jackson of South China investigated and the claim went to the Division of Animal Industry at the Department of Agriculture on March 8, 1968 but was refused payment by that department. The dogs were caught and later destroyed by Warden Jackson.
