STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Size of Conibear Traps for Trapping Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 1, amended. The last paragraph of subsection 1 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 22 of chapter 404 of the public laws of 1967 is further amended to read as follows:

Animals may be trapped with common ordinary steel traps and only size No. 110 and 120 and 220 killer-type traps. Killer-type traps larger than No. 120 may be used only under water. Killer-type traps of size No. 330 may be used above water in unorganized territory if at least ½ mile from any dwelling. Killer-type traps shall include the so-called Conibear trap and all other traps of that type.
