IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Posting Bonds by Defendants Under the Uniform Paternity Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 19, § 282, amended. Section 282 of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 325 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

§ 282. Security

The Upon complaint of the mother the court may at any time require the alleged father to give bond or other security for the payment of the judgment.
