AN ACT Providing for Unemployment Compensation for State and Municipal Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 1043, sub-§ 9, ¶ H, additional. Subsection 9 of section 1043 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph H, to read as follows:

H. This State, and its municipalities which shall be regarded as an employing unit.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 26, § 1043, sub-§ 11, ¶ F, sub-¶ (1), repealed and replaced. Subparagraph (1) of paragraph F of subsection 11 of section 1043 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

(1) Service performed in the employ of political subdivision or of any instrumentality of this State or its political subdivision, excepting municipalities;

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$27,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and the sum of \$36,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to carry out the purpose of this Act if the State lays off employees. Any unused portion of these state funds shall revert back to the General Fund at the end of each fiscal year.
