## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Placing Liquor Law Enforcement in Maine Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 1058, amended. Section 1058 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

### § 1058. Furnishing liquor to certain persons prohibited

Whoever knowingly procures or in any way aids or assists in procuring liquor or whoever furnishes, gives, sells or delivers liquor to a minor who may not legally purchase liquor for himself or for any intoxicated person, pauper, mentally ill person or person of known intemperate habits, except that this provision shall not apply to liquor served to a minor in a home in the presence of his parent or guardian, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.
