COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 826, L. D. 1065, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Sale of Liquor not to be Consumed on the Premises."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined
sentence of section 4 (same in L. D.) and inserting in place
thereof the following underlined sentence:

'Hotels, class A restaurants and club spirituous and vinous liquor
licensees, their clerks, servants or agents may sell liquor in the
original packages to be consumed elsewhere than upon the licensed
premises.'
