STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement Benefits for Call Firemen Under State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1092, sub-§ 5, amended. Subsection 5 of section 1092 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following:

Any participating local district which employs firefighters who are formally known as "call men" and exclusive of volunteer firefighters may extend all rights and benefits that are available under this section if said service may be equivalent to 60 days per year and each required attendance shall be counted as one day of service.
