HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 836, L. D. 1074, Bill, "AN ACT  
Creating the Oil and Gas Conservation and Development Control Act."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§2153" by inserting after  
the underlined word "oil" in the 2nd line of subsection 7 (same in L. D.)  
the underlined words 'originating from any well in the State'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2153" by inserting  
after the underlined word and comma "methods," in the 3rd line of  
subsection 12 (same in L. D.) the underlined words and comma  
'originating from any well in the State,'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2153" by inserting  
at the end of paragraph A, before the semicolon, of subsection 22  
(same in L. D.) the following underlined words 'of oil and gas'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2153" by  
inserting after subsection 21 the following new subsection:

'22. State. The words "in the State", "within the State",  
"in this State" or "within this State" mean in the State of Maine  
or under, in or on the offshore territorial waters of the State  
of Maine, wherever the context permits.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2153" by  
renumbering subsection 22 to be subsection 23.

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2155" by inserting after the underlined words "submerged pipelines" in the first line of paragraph F of subsection 3 (same in I. D.) the underlined words 'for the transportation of oil or gas or product'
